

The claims for arthritis, chronic knee pain and neck pain are dismissed. There is simply no evidence connecting these conditions to the contaminated water.

The claims for diarrhea (IBS) and mental distress are adjourned. The claimant is to see a specialist with reference to these conditions. It is not at all clear why there has been no improvement and the extent of pre-existing similar complaints requires elaboration and clarification. The administrator, if so advised, may refer the claimant for an independent medical and/or psychological or psychiatric examination.
